00. Philosophy

MensGo is a social network which allows its members to create their own individual online profiles with the aim of connecting with friends, both old and new. We are a community in the broadest sense of the word, a place where people from different backgrounds can find a special atmosphere where they feel welcome to share secrets, experiences and skills.

This is a place where you can feel comfortable in a friendly atmosphere and where you can find things (relationships, products and services) which fit with your lifestyle...

We live in a world where tolerance goes hand in hand with acknowledgement and acceptance and we wish to extend the invitation to all of our friends

MensGo Yes we go...

It's also a huge area for communication and freedom, which is open to anyone abiding by the rules.

01. Registration

To become a member of MensGo, register for free on the website and accept the charter.

Most categories of the website are accessible without restriction and free of charge, with the exception of the VIP area, which gives such VIP users the chance to discover various benefits, special invitations and services.

This agreement defines the binding legal terms and conditions relating to your use of the website and your membership of the service.

MensGo reserves the right to reject, refuse to display or delete at its sole discretion any announcement or notification (including e-mails) made by you, or to restrict, suspend or cancel your access to a part or all of the website or the service at any time, for whatever reason, with or without prior notice and without giving a reason.

02. Freedom of access

In accordance with the law, the site is open to all consenting adults.

In order to ensure compliance in this respect, MensGo is governed by certain moral regulations, which all users must comply with.

We do not systematically monitor the use of the site under normal conditions. We do, however, assume our obligations with regard to members. We submit all profiles created on MensGo for review and check instant messages if certain key words are flagged up.

If we discover or have reason to believe that a member is not an adult, then we also reserve the right to immediately restrict access to said member's account without prior notice and – if required by law – suspend or cancel the member's subscription to the site.

03. Acceptance of the MensGo charter

Your presence on, utilisation of, identification on and affiliation with MensGo implies that you have accepted and comply with all terms and conditions contained in the basic regulations (the charter).

MensGo is entitled to change or alter these terms and conditions without prior notice. You accept the fact that you are bound to any changes in this agreement as long as you use the service. Members shall be informed of any modifications that have taken place the next time they access the website.

This agreement includes the MensGo policy on acceptable usage and on the content displayed by the website, your rights, obligations and restrictions concerning your use of the website and the services of MensGo «Privacy Policy».

04. Member commitment

By registering on MensGo, members shall commit themselves to maintaining a friendly, pleasant and respectful atmosphere.

Members shall refrain from all communication or correspondence which could:

- ◇ be considered as defamatory, misleading, harassment or threatening by anyone else or violate the rights of others in any way, particularly individual rights, including the right of privacy.

04c. Third Party Content

The following is an incomplete list of content which is illegal or prohibited on the website. MensGo reserves the right to investigate and take legal action at its sole discretion against anyone in violation of these stipulations, including, without limitation, removing any potentially litigious content from the service and cancelling subscriptions as a result.

Prohibited content includes the following:

- I. Content which is openly aggressive and encourages racism, sectarianism, hate or physical or any other kind of violence against a group of people or an individual.
- II. Content which advocates the harassment of another person.
- III. Content which involves the forwarding of junk mail or chain letters, or the direct sending of unsolicited spam.
- IV. Content which distributes information which you know to be false or deceptive.
- V. Content which promotes illegal activities.
- VI. Content which has an abusive, threatening, obscene, defamatory or slanderous intention.

Members shall be prohibited from :

- VII. publishing, posting, downloading, saving, distributing or disseminating all topics, names or information which are inappropriate, insulting in terms of religious beliefs, anti-Semitic, immoral, defamatory, obscene, indecent, unlawful, harmful, heinous, fascist, xenophobic, racist or otherwise prejudicial to human dignity or which violate any other rights, particularly those concerning intellectual property;
- VIII. making illegal or unauthorised copies of property belonging to others, such as supplying pirated software or music files, or any links to them; from supplying information which allows copying to be carried out, or from circumventing implemented protection measures;
- IX. to publish the pages contains restricted or password-only access pages, or hidden pages or images (those not linked to or from another accessible page of the Website);

- X. providing material which exploits others in a sexual or violent manner, or soliciting personal information of minors;
- XI. providing information concerning illegal activities such as the manufacture or sale of arms, the violation of privacy of another person or the provision or creation of a computer virus;

- XX. We shall decide on measures to be taken against members who do not respect the MensGo charter on a case-by-case basis.

05. Become a VIP member

Payments for VIP subscriptions can be made in euros or US dollars, just as payments for any other service offered by the website can be.

The minimal contract duration of a subscription is defined in the subscription details.

06. Personal information

Members commit to providing accurate information for the use of MensGo. (We consider the rights of MensGo users as a very serious matter; please refer to our [confidentiality agreement](#).)

Members shall have their own user names and passwords in order to access MensGo. It is forbidden for a user to create a false identity or to assume an existing identity with the intention of deceiving other people. If this happens, the member concerned shall be banned and his or her dishonest activities shall be denounced.

You have sole responsibility in terms of your interaction and communication with other members.

Users are not able to remain anonymous whilst using the internet, registering or posting text or images within the framework of MensGo.

The user's IP address and e-mail address are stored together with the exact time of day.

In the event of a breach of the law, the aforementioned information can be disclosed to the police or to criminal justice authorities.

07. User name: Password and privacy

Members are solely responsible for keeping their user names, passwords and all activities whilst using their account secret.

Members shall commit themselves to immediately informing MensGo of any unauthorised use of their account or of all other violations of security measures they become aware of.

MensGo cannot, under any circumstances, be held responsible for damages suffered as a result of other people using your account.

Any fraudulent use, use not in compliance with these terms and conditions or misconduct shall give MensGo the right to restrict, suspend or delete your account without prior notice and without being liable for any form of refund, whether in part or in full, for any amounts of money paid in the form of subscriptions.

Definitions :

If are unsure as to the meaning of a word, please consult a dictionary so that we all use the same language.

Here is glossary of some words which are used in our community.

General vocabulary

Erection: A physical reaction which takes place in certain tissue or organs (penis, clitoris, nipples) meaning that they become stiff, rigid or swollen.

Erotic: Relates to sex, pleasure and various sexual desires related to procreation.

Eroticism: A strong liking of sexual pleasure. The quality or character of being erotic.

Ethnic group: Group of individuals who share a certain number of characteristics, particularly language and culture (whereas the word «race» refers only to physical characteristics). Indistinct idea which groups together human beings who more or less have a common socio-cultural heritage such as a language, a religion or similar traditions.

Gay: Refers to male homosexuality, homosexuals.

Homosexuality: Defines the practice of sexual and emotional relations with people of the same sex or sexual attraction to people of the same sex. The word is used for both men and women.

Biology of homosexuality

«We are born homosexual, you do not choose to be. Homosexuality must be considered as a variation of biological characteristics. Homosexuals are in no way responsible for their sexual orientation.»

Insult: An attack on someone with offensive intentions or acts. Action of offending or verbally abusing someone, either intentionally or accidentally.

Intolerance: «It's not something that's innate, it's something you acquire!» Collin Farrell

Kiss-In

Definition: The act of touching or pressing together with pursed lips and then often make a clapping sound when separating in an expression of affectation, love, friendship, respect, etc.: He kissed his son on the cheek.

A kiss-in is a form of demonstration which consists of

people kissing in public or in a public building or place. This form of demonstration came about in homosexual communities in America during the 1980s and has become popular in countries all over Europe and the world. Homosexual couples participate in kiss-ins in order to create awareness about homosexuality by defying the secrecy with which society treats it.

A kiss-in was organised in Italy on 2nd August 2007 in front of the Coliseum. This was a response to the arrest of a gay couple who had kissed in front of the same monument on 27th July. This was probably the first kiss-in to be widely reported in European media after the one organised during the Act Up-Paris event on 17th May 2007 for the International Day Against Homophobia in front of the Nigeria embassy in Paris as a protest against homophobia in the African state.

These kiss-in events have spread all over the world and «kissing attacks» have been organised in France (Paris), Canada, Switzerland, Belgium, Australia (Sydney) and Peru (Lima).

Lesbianism: Feminine homosexuality, sapphism

Lesbian: Female homosexual. «Dyke» is a modern, pejorative word.

Nudity: Being undressed; part of the human body being naked, naked skin (in terms of parts of the body which are usually covered).

Puberty: Transition from childhood to adolescence; a group of physiological changes accompanied by psychological changes which transform a child into a human being capable of procreating.

Sex: Sexual parts; external genital organs. Particular configuration which distinguishes man from woman by assigning them with a defined role in procreation and bestows them with certain distinct characteristics.

Sexuality: Collection of types of behaviour referring to sexual instinct and satisfaction (whether or not associated with the genitals).

Total-Flex

This is an adjective which differentiates between an active person and a passive person during sexual relations, in other words the giver and the receiver, with the objective of deriving and giving pleasure in the following activities:

Definition of prohibited activities:

Anti-Semitism: Hostile attitude towards Jewish people
This hostility can range from individual aversion to forms of ideological and institutional persecution.

Defamation: Attempting to tarnish the reputation or honour of another person. Defamation constitutes a non-indictable offence or an infringement of the law according to whether it is carried out in public or in private.

Faggot: pejorative word for a homosexual

Fascism: This ideology rejects human rights, individual freedom and liberalism. The fascist social model is focussed on the nation rather than the individuals that make up a nation. It is therefore a fundamental part of fascism to maintain the homogeneity (ethnic, religious or class homogeneity) of the national community. The group of people must have a leader, the authority of whom may not be called into question. Under the exclusion of all opposition to the system, fascism is a model which sees itself as totalitarian. The main tasks in a fascist society are to encourage values such as patriotism, purity and the idea of the «redevelopment» of the nation. People designated as «enemies», «traitors» and «sub-humans» must be wiped out.

Homophobia: Explicit or implicit hostility towards homosexuals. This hostility concerns fear, hatred, aversion and disapproval towards homosexuality. By extension, homophobia refers to anti-homosexual prejudice and discrimination.

Obscene: Those who offend decency through vulgar representations and expressions concerning sexuality. This is a moral notion which has varied considerably over the course of history. Those seen as obscene are considered reproachable and reprehensible.

Paedophilia: The sexual attraction of an adult or an adolescent towards pre-pubescent children. A person with

this attraction – and who potentially puts it into practice – can be considered a paedophile. A sexual relationship between an adult and a child, something which paedophilia can lead to, is strongly condemned in the vast majority of the world's legal systems, considered as a serious crime and a major transgression of social standards characterised under the term «the sexual abuse of children».

Pederast: 1 Man who has sexual relations with young boys. Paedophile.

2 By extension: Vulgar connotation. Man who has sexual relations with other men. Homosexual.

Pornography: The explicit representation of sexual acts using various technical and artistic means (writing, drawings, paintings, photos, videos) or obscene material intended to be released to the general public.

Racism: The theory of a racial hierarchy which stipulates the necessity of the protection of the «superior» race from any interbreeding along with the right to dominate other races. The most common use of the word is to define an attitude of contempt, hostility and even violence towards individual belonging to a different ethnic group.

Violate/rape: 1 Act against, harm (something that must be respected), carrying out violence towards

2 Opening, penetrating inside (a sacred place or one protected by the law). Violate a burial place.

3 Act of violence whereby a individual (rapist) forces sexual relations involving penetration on another person against their will. Sexual abuse. To rape a boy.

Xenophobia: Literally «the fear of strangers». Hostility towards foreigners, in other words towards people who do not belong to the same national, linguistic or cultural group as the xenophobe.
